CCAD currently consists of a K-2nd grade lower elementary school, a 3rd-5th grade upper elementary school, middle school with grades 6th-8th, and a high school consisting of grades 9th-12th. CCAD is the first charter district in the state of Michigan accredited by North Central Association; and currently, the CCAD population consists of approximately 2,200 students. Authorized by Saginaw Valley State University, managed by The Leona Group and accredited by AdvancEd, CCAHS is located in the heart of Michigan's largest Latino community - Southwest Detroit.
